USE OF A PHYSICAL TRACTOR FOR MORE THAN ONE TRACTOR MODEL

\*\*\*\*\*

*Note:* The term “tractor model” used in this Board Action refers to a tractor model for Nebraska sales permitting purposes, as defined in Board Action No. 27, which may or may not be the same criteria any particular manufacturer uses to distinguish among their tractor manufacturer’s models.

*Rationale:* For some families of tractor models, agricultural tractor manufacturers have reached a point where two or more models of tractor are the same, except for the electronic engine control program.

Therefore, the Nebraska Tractor Test Board allows the testing of one physical tractor for multiple tractor models. In order to fully document each tractor model so tested, agricultural tractor manufacturers shall specify sufficient additional information to fully define each tractor model. Such specifications may vary by tractor model but may include items such as ECM part or model number, software part numbers, and version numbers, etc.


