
IN CAB SOUND TESTS


When making recommendations for permanent Nebraska sales permits, a measure of sound level will be required. This can be accomplished by providing a sound level measurement using recognized standards or codes.

1. When a tractor is submitted for test to the Nebraska Tractor Test Laboratory and no OECD sound test is requested, a sound level measurement will be made using the “without load procedure” of OECD Code 5. This single point-sound level measurement will be included in the published report.
2. When tractors are tested at other OECD test stations and no official Code 5 sound test is performed, a sound level measurement using either the OECD Code 5 “without load procedure” or the ISO 5131:1996 “no drawbar load” procedure will be required for a Nebraska sales permit. The manufacturer may:
 - a. request that the OECD test station obtain a sound level measurement using one of these official test procedures. This sound level measurement must accompany other documentation required for issuance of a sales permit.
 - b. submit to the Nebraska Tractor Test Laboratory a model of the tractor being offered for sale in Nebraska. A sound level measurement will be obtained using the procedure of (1) above.


A sound level will be published for all tractor models offered for sale in Nebraska.
